ART in the PARK is an annual juried art event sponsored by the Artists' Group of Charlestown, in cooperation with the Friends of City Square Park. ART in the PARK 2009 will be held in the award winning City Square Park, Charlestown, MA on Saturday September 12th, 2009 (rain date Sunday September 13th).

Since 1998 ART in the PARK has consistently attracted talented artists from the New England area and beyond, becoming an extremely popular event.

The ART in the PARK 2009 Committee asks all applicants to submit by July 15th.

The Committee will review and accept applicants based on creativity, originality of the work, presentation, and medium. **We will reserve the right to limit exhibitors in any one medium.** Space is limited within the Park Acceptance letters will be sent by July 30th.

We will require that all applicants provide photographs or slides of recent work, even if they have exhibited in the past.

Art in the Park provides exhibition space of 10 feet by 10 feet for approximately 65 artists. All proceeds from sales at Art in the Park 2009 are the property of the artist and **no commission will be taken.** All artists **MUST** be present for the daylong event.

Artists will be accepted to exhibit by the ART in the PARK Committee based on the following criteria:

- 1.) Applications will be considered for work in mediums of 2 and 3 dimensional original artwork including acrylic, oil, mixed media and watercolor painting, original prints and/or limited editions prints, photography, sculpture, glass and pottery, jewelry, fabric, textile or clothing design and other fine arts mediums.
- 2.) **Only original artwork created by the applying artist will be allowed at the event.**
- 3.) Medium submitted for acceptance must represent recent work of artist.
- 4.) **Application packages must include:**
 1. 3 to 5 slides and/or photographs or samples of representational work,
 2. Applications must be received by July 15th 2009 with an application fee of \$80.00 and mailed to: Artists' Group of Charlestown, Art in the Park 2008 P.O. Box 290164 Charlestown, MA 02129.
 3. Self addressed stamped envelope for the return of application materials.
 4. Completed form below.

REMEMBER: APPLICATIONS MUST BE POSTMARKED BY JULY 15th 2009

We will select sites for each artist and we ask exhibitors to respect these designated boundaries. Please do not ask to change your assigned area as informational materials have been printed for you and those attending the event.

Please note: all set up, tear down, display materials and clean up are your responsibility. Not all tents and or canopies are suitable to the park venue and if used, all sidewalls must remain open. Please read and complete the following application form carefully. We look forward to your participation and encourage you to let your friends and patrons know about this event. Postcards for this event are available for participating artists and will be included in your "acceptance packet".
